FRENCH MARTINI – Vodka, Chambord, Pineapple juice, shaken over ice
Invented as part of an advertising campaign by Chambord, this deliciously tart and sweet combination of flavours is a perfect end of day treat!

KIR ROYALE – Sparkling Crémant wine, Crème de Cassis
A popular variation on Kir, combining sparkling French wine and cassis, a sweet dark red liqueur made from blackcurrants.

ST-GERMAIN GIN & TONIC – Tanqueray Gin, St-Germain, Tonic
The addition of the delicate flavour of the St-Germain has created a crisp and refreshing version of the G&T!

TANGERINE TWIST – Cointreau, Amaretto, Crème de Cassis, Orange juice
A tangy cocktail filled with rich orange flavours balanced with sweet almond and blackcurrant.

CHAMBORD COSMOPOLITAN – Vodka, Cointreau, Cranberry juice, Chambord
Taking the original vodka, Cointreau and cranberry ingredients and adding some Parisian panache with the addition of Chambord.

FRENCH 75 – Gin, Lemon juice and sugar syrup, shaken over ice, topped with Sparkling wine
Named after an innovative piece of French artillery due to having such a 'kick', this is a zingy cocktail with a touch of fizz. Simply called a 'Soixante Quinze' in French (75).

MOJITO PARISIEN – Bacardi, St-Germain, Lime juice, Mint leaves and Lemonade
A delicious French twist on the Mojito, Parisian style with the addition of St-Germain.

PEACH ROSÉ BELLINI – White Peach Purée, Sparkling Crémant rosé wine
A beautifully Gallic style Bellini.

CHOCOLATE ORANGE – Bailey's, Cointreau, Chocolate liqueur, Milk, Cream
A luxurious, velvet cocktail that's almost a dessert!

SPARKLING CRANBERRY – Vodka, Cointreau, Cranberry juice, splash of lime, soda water
A refreshing drink based on the Chambord Cosmo. This lovely long drink is full of flavour and topped with soda.

Roussanne - Domaine La Criox Gratiot £ 19.95
LANGUEDOC-ROUSSILLON

Flavours of mandarin, pear, fennel, and Asian spice are balanced with minimal acidity, lovely wine made from a relatively undiscovered gem of a grape variety, perfect with any fish dish.

Albariño - El Cante Rias Baixas £ 21.95
SPAIN

Another wine currently growing in popularity. This will appeal to Sauvignon and Chardonnay lovers alike with its stone fruit flavours and refreshing acidity on the finish.

Vermintino - Is Argiolas £ 23.50
SARDINIA

Single vineyard, concentrated citrus, tangerine tropical fruit hints, immediately attractive with a rich balance of fruit and acidity. Fine delicate wine.

Chablis - Cape St Martin - 2014 £ 25.00
BURGUNDY

Classic Chablis. One of the few wines that even non-Chardonnay drinkers cannot help but love!

Sancerre – Berthier - 2013 £ 27.50
LOIRE

Sancerre is the spiritual home of Sauvignon Blanc. Less in your face than its Marlborough cousin but no less good quality. Steely, clean and a cracking mineral infused finish.

Gavi DOCG del commune di Gavi 'White Label' - La Scolca - 2014 £29.50
ITALY

The Scoldati family are regarded as the premium wine producers in Gavi. Apple, peach & honey, a hint of lime with almond and herbal aroma, stunning combined with fresh fish, chicken or hard cheeses.

Lugana DOC – Sansonina - 2013 £32.00
ITALY

Owned, managed and controlled by Carla Prospero and Nadia Zenato, these two ladies have created a legend with their Sansonina wines. Handpicked, no oak contact, wild flowers on the nose with a touch of mango, this is stunning!



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Saint Aubin 'En Vesvau' Château de Santenay – 2012 £35.00

BURGUNDY

This Saint Aubin comes from just 4 hectares in En Vesvau, fermented and aged for just over 12 months in oak, 20% of which is new. It has good depth, a touch of smokiness and nice minerality. The wine is intense with great elegance and finesse.

Chablis 1er Cru 'Les Vaudevey' Domaine Laroche - 2011 £37.50

BURGUNDY

Domaine Laroche epitomises Chablis and has been built up over the past 160 years. The quality of their wines is impeccable! This 1er Cru is bright gold in colour with an elegant nose which abounds with citrus aromas and mineral overtones.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc Chateau de Vaudieu - 2012 £45.00

RHÔNE

The Château is a splendid 18th century property, once owned by the négociant Gabriel Meffre and now run by his grandson, Laurent Bréchet who has transformed the estate over the past seven years with an obsession for quality. Out of 40 hectares, 10 are assigned to Whites from vines with an average age of 30 years old. A blend of Roussanne and Grenache Blanc, this is a truly complex and stunning wine to top our list!

Ribera del Duero DO – Reserva Comenge - 2009/10
SPAIN

Ripe black fruit, herb and balsamic on the nose. 14 months in French and American oak give this wine an incredible depth, significantly better than a comparable Rioja.

Chianti Classico DOCG – Riserva Poggio a'Fрати - 2010
ITALY

Poggio a'Fрати loosely translated to farm of fathers produces the 2010 Riserva. Intense fruit character and complex layered flavours, aged 2 to 3 years in wood, 1 in the bottle. Stunning!

Crozes-Hermitage – Nicholas Perrin - 2012
RHÔNE

Nicholas Perrin brings together the scions of two of the great families of the Rhône, Nicholas Jaboulet and the Perrin family of Château de Beaucastel. This joint venture micro-négociant was created with the sole aim of producing the absolute best quality Northern Rhône wines and the result is absolutely incredible!

Gigondas – Domaine des Bosquets - 2011
RHÔNE

£36.50

Home to the first Gigondas vines in 1376, Domaine des Bosquets now has 26 hectares of vines (up to 75 years old) lying directly under the imposing 350m high Dentelles de Montmirail. This height and prominence to the warm Southern sun creates a beautiful, powerful and complex wine with a nose of blackberries, violets and liquorice.

Margaux - Ségla - 2006
BORDEAUX

The second wine and second growth of Rauzan-Ségla, a highly regarded Bordeaux Second Growth (1855 Classification). This property was actually purchased by the family who own Chanel who installed the old wine-making team from Château Latour. Classic Margaux fruits with hints of violet and cedar. A truly exceptional wine and incredible value at this price.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape – Domaine La Milliere AOC - 2009
RHÔNE

Handpicked grapes made in a biodynamic style. Michel Arnaud is producing some of the finest wines from 80-100 year old vines. The 2009 vintage has the classic blend of 60% Grenache, 10% Syrah, 10% Mourvèdre, 10% Cinsault & 10% Cunoise. Simply stunning depth and finish!

His 2011 vintage is ripe but elegant with lovely intensity from the old vines. A classic in the making!

L'Extra par Langlois Rosé – Crémant de Loire

Langlois is owned by Champagne house Bollinger and their expertise can be seen having a stunning effect on the quality of these wines. The Cabernet Franc in this rosé has delicate berry tones, perfect for an aperitif whilst chatting and looking through the menu!



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Nicolas Feuillatte N.V. £ 37.50

A light, fresh and fruity Champagne with fine discreet bubbles and subtle overtones of apple, pears, and citrus fruits. This wonderful Champagne has undergone a total of 4 years' ageing prior to release and tastes fabulous!

Taittinger Brut Réserve £ 47.50

One of the last Champagne houses to be owned and managed by the name on the label, Taittinger is distinguished by the high proportion of Chardonnay in the blend, giving this fizz a real elegance.

Taittinger Rosé £ 55.00

Salmon pink in colour, this rosé fizz shows bright summer fruits and a touch of spice, simply delicious, divine and a well deserved treat!

LANGUEDOC-ROUSSILLON

From the same vintage as the year Chez Jules opened, this absolutely stunning dessert wine comes from Domaine Cazes, the largest certified Organic and Biodynamic estate in France. It was founded in 1895 and is still headed up 4 generations on by Emmanuel Cazes. Deep amber in colour, with aromas of dried fruit and candied fruit peel gives this wine great intensity and lovely balance which prevent it from being cloying. Another fine revelation from 1997!
